Relevant Experience

Windsor Village Apartments (Windsor, Vermont)

Rehabilitation of 77 residential units configured in three buildings and located on a 4.48 acre site. The boilers are being replaced with a biomass system. This project is a complete rehab of all electrical and mechanical systems and also includes upgrades to the building envelope and interior architectural finishes. A minor amount of sitework will be done to address areas on site.

Lakebridge on Compass Drive (Newport, Vermont)

The project included a total of 21 units of both new and renovated. Three historic multifamily residential buildings. Five existing multifamily residential buildings and a carriage house associated with the house on Pleasant Street was demolished in order to make room for two new buildings. The project also included 2 new buildings with 14 units and the new 6-unit facility including a common laundry and on-site management office.

West River Valley Assisted Living (Townshend, Vermont)

Banwell Architects completed this facility with Valley Cares, a nonprofit organization committed to providing affordable housing and supportive services to the elderly residents of the West River Valley and surrounding towns.

Kendal Retirement Community (Hanover, New Hampshire)

Kendal at Hanover is a full-service, not for profit, continuing care retirement community affiliated with The Kendal Corporation. We are working with the community to develop design solutions for five major initiatives and to lead the master planning, design and engineering.

Merten's House (Woodstock, VT)

Banwell developed plans to renovate interior spaces for a long term senior care facility as well as add an addition to fill in the existing courtyard on a very tight parcel of land. The new addition created a new resident dining room as well as a resident lounge/activity room.
