




Ingrid Nichols, AIA, LAP Principal in Charge/Design Principal

Cardigan Mountain School Kenerson & Wakely (Canaan, NH)

Banwell designed a second story addition to the existing hockey rink locker room building. The second floor included a fitness room, locker rooms, offices, wrestling room/exercise room, meeting room and athletic lounge area. The Kenerson renovation includes renovating 225 student locker rooms, a new toilet and shower facility, new locker rooms for male and female faculty and renovations to team rooms.

Campus Center Vermont Technical College (Randolph, VT)

The Campus Center project combined a new 13,000 sf addition to the existing Shape facility at the south side of the campus at VTC. The building is LEED Gold certified and included dining, kitchen, lounge and fitness facilities.

Jay Peak New Stateside Mountain Learning Center (Jay Vermont)

The Mountain Learning Center (MLC) is a freestanding building, approximately 8,000sf, located north of existing Stateside Base Lodge in a wooded area that was partially cleared and developed with surface lifts to form a beginner learning area.

Woodstock Recreation Center (Woodstock, VT)

The renovation to the Main Building included: A 1,400 sq fitness center, 1,000 sf dance studio, changing and locker room facilities, administrative offices, conference room, teen lounge, game room, and indoor snack bar.

Meeting House Theater Proctor Academy (Andover, NH)

Banwell Architects designed a Meeting House Theater facility sited in the center of the campus as a focal point for the Arts Quad.
