Relevant Experience

CMS Hayward Dormitory (Canaan, NH)

The Hayward Dorm Renovation project consists of a renovation of a prior kitchen/dining facility into new dorm rooms. All electrical and mechanical systems will be updated. The building envelope and attic insulation will be renovated and new windows installed for a high performance envelope. Faculty apartments will have patios and decks and separate entries.

CMS Kenerson & Wakely (Canaan, NH)

Banwell designed a second story addition to the existing hockey rink locker room building. The second floor includes a fitness room, locker rooms, offices, wrestling room/exercise room, meeting room and athletic lounge area.

Proctor Academy Maxwell Savage (Andover, NH)

Banwell Architects was selected to design renovations to an existing building to provide space for student activities center, kitchen and dining area, bookstore, billiard room, and informal gathering spaces for a student center on a private school campus.

Cardigan Mountain School Dormitory (Canaan, NH)

The construction of two new buildings for Faculty & Student Housing included a center clapboard and block "house" for 12 students, including toilets, storage and Living Rooms, plus three attached wood-framed Faculty housing units: (1) 3-bedroom, (1) 2-bedroom and (1) 1-bedroom. The housing is sited on the sloping lawn west of Hinman Crawford Way and is accessible by a new driveway with 5 parking spaces for each building.

Proctor Academy Meeting House Theater (Andover, NH)

Banwell Architects was asked to design a new Meeting House Theater facility sited in the center of the campus as a focal point for the Arts Quad. It is used on a daily basis for morning student assembly, as well as throughout the year for theatrical events and classes for dance and drama. The building's design evokes a New England barn-like vernacular and blends harmoniously with the rest of the campus.
