CVUHS (Hinesburg, VT)

The woodchip-fired heating plant was a major part of a wide range of efficiency strategies implemented at the high school, which provide combined yearly savings to the school of approximately \$180,000.

Grafton County Biomass (North Haverhill, NH)

A high capacity (7MMBTU/HR) automated woodchip fired central heating plant for Grafton County Complex; in addition to a working farm, the complex includes a Courthouse, Prison, Nursing Home and Administration building.
